# **BRITISH GYMNASTICS AWARDS**

Our Primary School aged gymnasts are busy working hard to achieve their BG Core Proficiency Awards. The programme is well underway, and we will soon see the first gymnasts achieving their first badges and certificates.

There are 8 awards to achieve with 8 being the easiest level and 1 the hardest. The Coaches have picked the most appropriate level for their classes to work towards.

Each award has 10 skills to master over a 6-week period (approximately).

All our gymnasts have been issued a Personal Development Card, so you can use it to help track their progress at home.



# THE BIG BALANCE

All the parents of our Recreational Gymnasts received an email last week about the upcoming BIG Balance event. The event is happening on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> March.

This is a great opportunity to see your child in action in the gym and also see the skills they have been working on over the past 6 weeks.

The gymnasts will perform two short routines, one on the floor and one on the beam. This is our BIG Balance event so the main aim is for the gymnasts to perform controlled, stylish skills in a small sequence. All the gymnasts will be marked out of 10, from these marks everyone will get a medal, but it will be dependent on how high the score is to what colour medal the gymnasts will receive!

The coaches will be preparing the gymnasts for this event over the next couple of weeks. Lots of practicing will be going on in the gyms ready for this fun challenge.

We expect you will see lots of balancing going on at home!

## **BUILDING UPDATE**

**New Tythe Street** - Redecoration of the cafe area was delayed in February, but freshly painted walls are on the agenda for early March!

More roof repairs were completed during February as we had further incidents of 'lead theft' causing leaks in the gym. We are in the process of getting quotes for a suspended ceiling for the Party Room (as we know the roof panels are unsightly)!

We will also be replacing the front door at New Tythe Street, hopefully before the end of March!

**Ilkeston** - The gas installation is still not quite complete, but we are literally now just awaiting the installation of a gas meter and then it will be all systems go! However, we are secretly hoping that this glorious weather continues, and we won't need the heating on until next winter ... ever the optimists!

We had an amazing group of parent volunteers help to clear our front offices in February as we work behind the scenes on the extension project! These front upstairs offices will soon be home to fitness equipment and showering/changing facilities as we welcome a new personal trainer to our location. More details to follow in March!

Whilst nothing is very visible at the minute, we have made great progress with getting electrics fitted in our middle office block, suspended ceilings are being fitted and walls being dry lined as we speak. This will enable our coaching and admin staff to relocate to the middle block offices which will become our central Hub in the next phase!

The demolition of the unused warehouse at the back of our rear gym will commence early March - making space for much needed parking as we extend the rear gym! The area will be secured with fencing with health and safety of our gymnasts, parents and visitors of paramount importance.

The day was great success for all and our world Gymnaestrada Display Team got the chance to run their routine with their partner team Trix Academy.




# **BQT - RHYTHMIC**

# **EAST MIDLANDS FLOOR AND VAULT COMPETITION**

Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> February saw 21 of our Men's Artistic squad travel to Leicester to compete in the East Midlands Regional Floor and Vault Championships.

In the under 9 category Ollie Wallis put in a fantastic performance to finish 4<sup>th</sup> missing out on the bronze medal by only 0.05 and only 0.25 off the gold medal.

Another solid performance and a heart-breaking result for Benjamin Batton-Plowright in Regional under 10 who also finished 4<sup>th</sup> just 0.15 behind the bronze medal. Medal success too for Mark Storer who took the bronze for Non-Regional under 10.

Our first gold of the day came to Luke Stuart in the Non-Regional under 11 who put in a blinding performance. Joining him on the podium by showcasing new harder routines and taking bronze was EVGC's Jacob Block.

In the under 12 category Kwadwo Afirifah-Mensah demonstrated mastery of his new routines and brought home the bronze medal. The under 13 category and another 2 EVGC boys on the podium with William Fergusson taking Gold and Jack Morgan bronze. These boys will both be going on the compete at the British championships at the M&S Bank Arena in Liverpool next month.

Under 14 Non-Regional we saw Brayden Clarke take the silver medal with very clean and tidy routines and more success in the under 16 Category where Finn Dineen nailed his landings to take the gold.

In a very high level Over 16 category Henry Richards and Ewan Moody put in solid performances to finish 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respectively.

















# **MEET THE 2018 COACH OF THE YEAR**
